In a hen roost five hens overhear another hen say she gets more beautiful when she pulls out a feather. To impress the rooster, they take her words seriously!



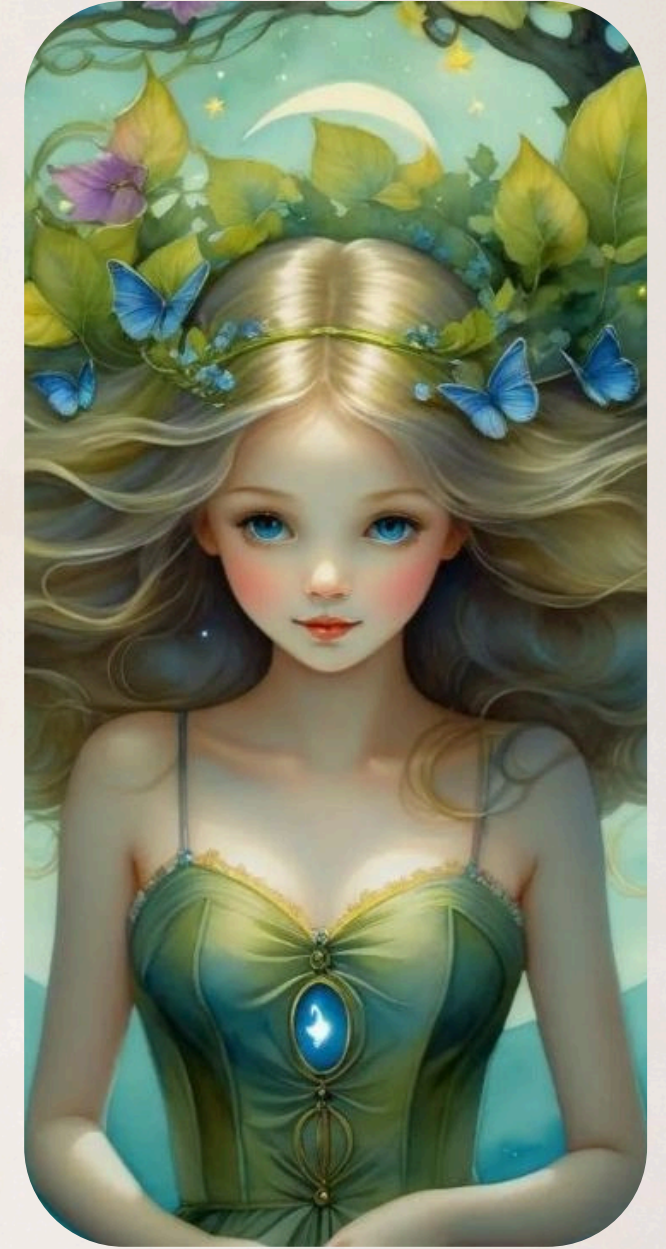
She Was Good for Nothing – 19:45 – Hans Christian Anderson

A little Match Girl goes out in Winter to sell her matches.



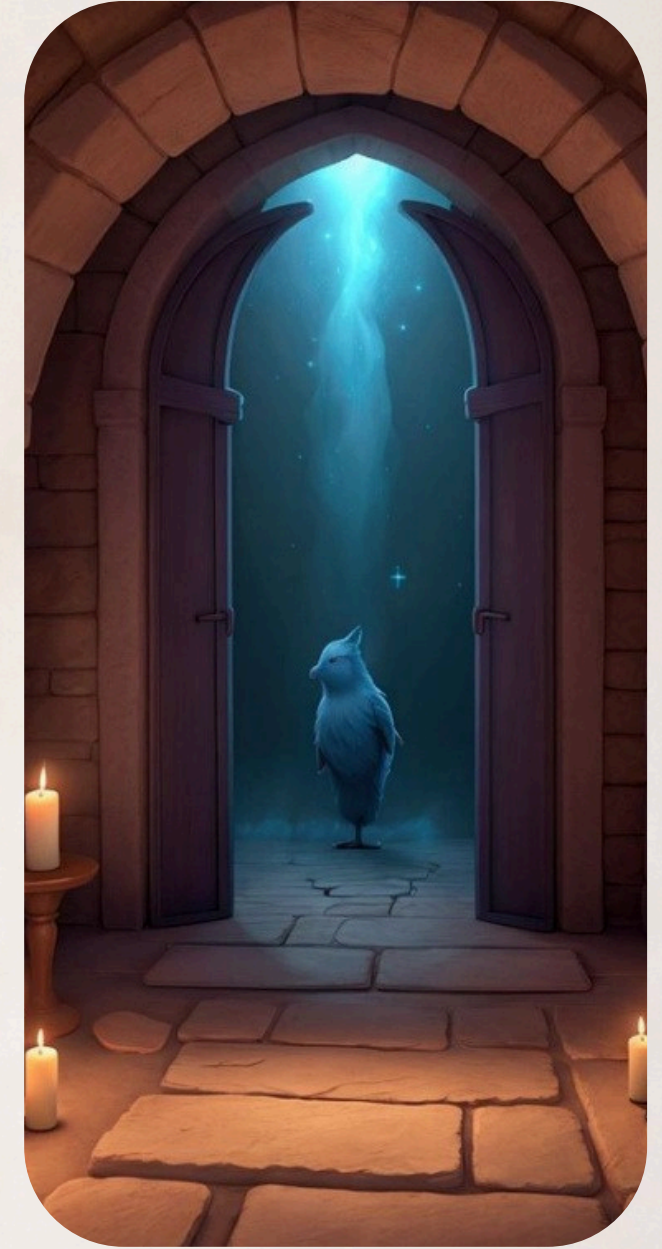
Hansel & Gretel – 17:51 – Hans Christian Anderson

A man sitting alone late at night hears a talking Raven's call at his window.



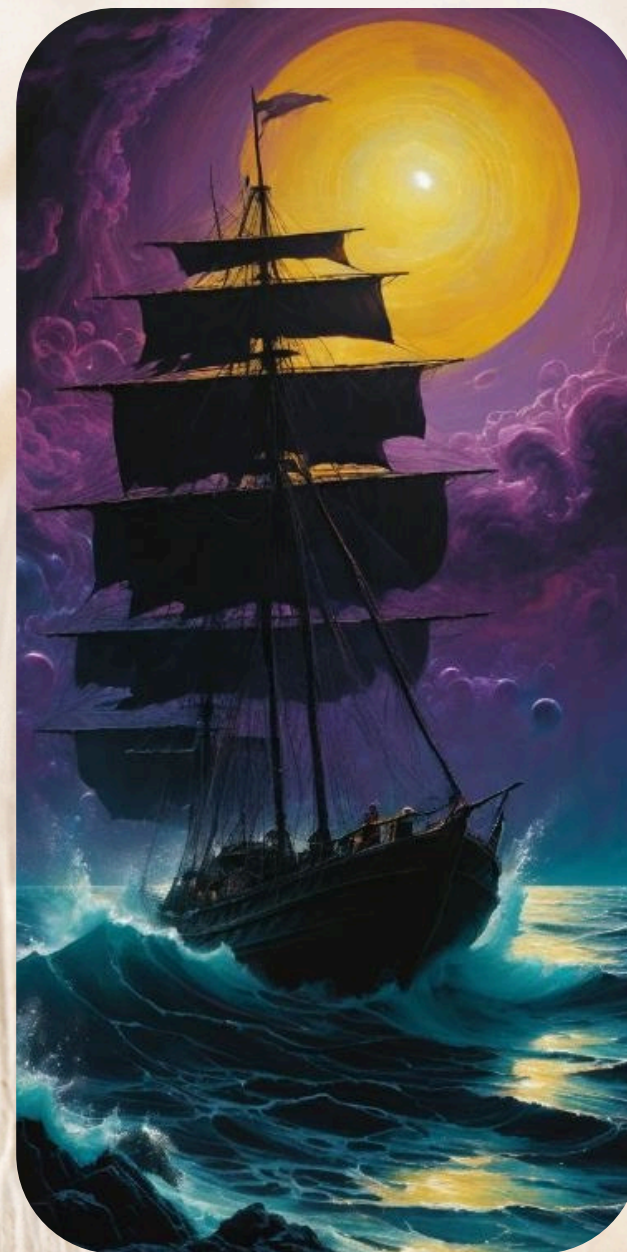

A coffee plantation owner in 20th century Brazil defends his property and workers from a hoard of killer ants said to be ten miles long and two miles wide.

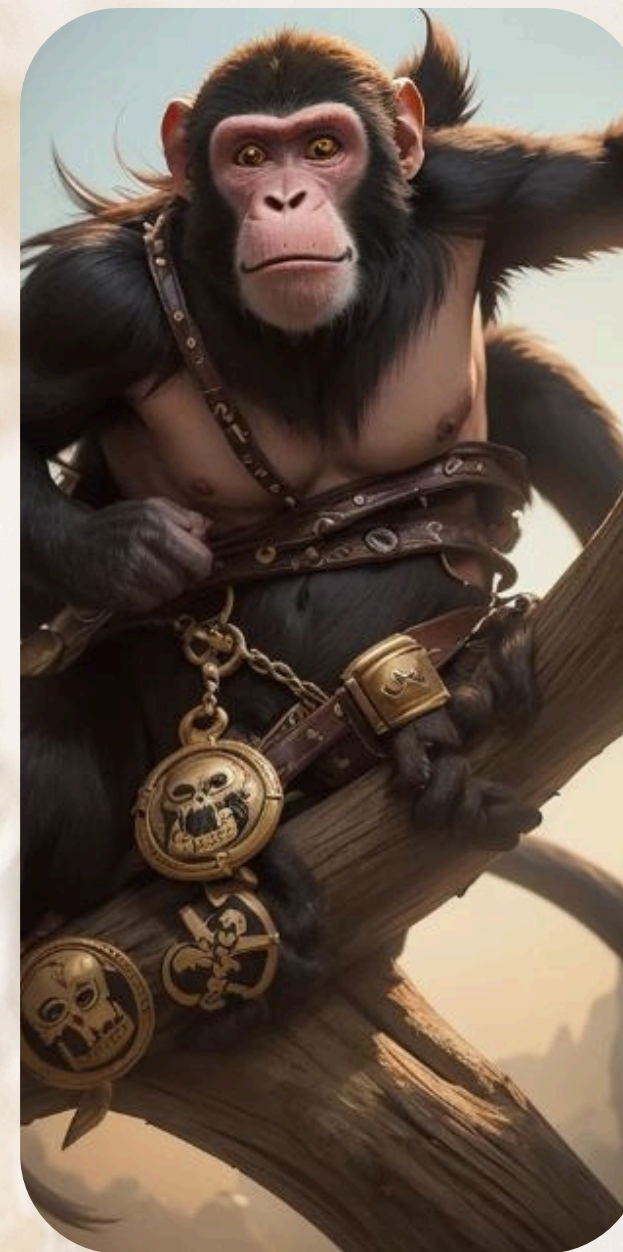


Gabriel Ernest 17:19 H.H. Monro

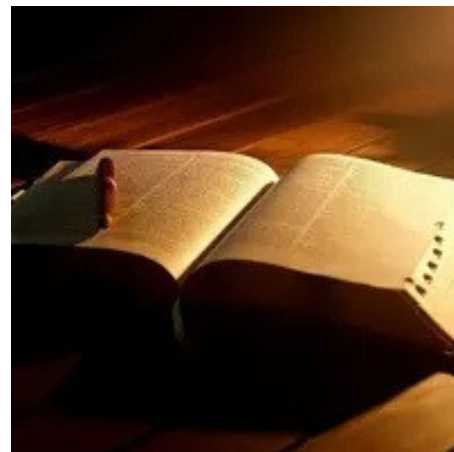

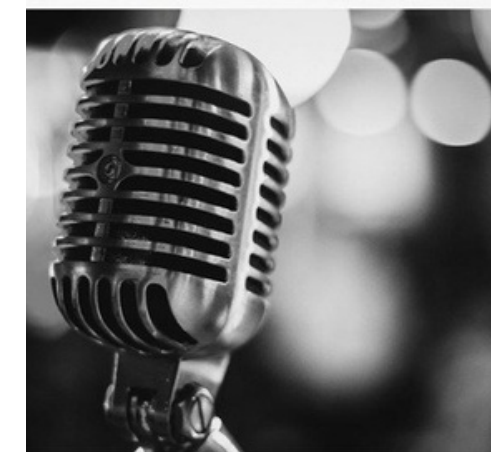
